FININVEST: MILAN AC HAS INVESTED 237 MILLION EUROS SINCE 2005

In relation to the news of protests carried out by some groups on the Internet, Fininvest makes clear – as regards those who complain little is being invested - that Milan AC invested 237 million Euros in players between 2005 and 2009. This policy was possible because of the commitment of Fininvest, which since 2003 has also dedicated new financial resources to the soccer team with a capital increase of approximately 220 million Euros.

Once again, Fininvest denies in the most categorical terms that the club is for sale, instead insisting that aims are to add new, prestigious accomplishments to those that have made Milan AC the most titled team in the world.
